**BETI BACHAO BETI PADHAO SCHEME FOR ADMISSION
FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2023.**

1. **“Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao”** This programme has been implemented through campaign with the objective of improvement in sex ratio through societal change; to prevent sex selective abortion, protection of the girl child, education of the girl child and increase in girls’ participation in the field of sports. The programme was launched on 22nd January, 2015 by Hon’ble Prime Minister of India. It has been implemented through out India.

2. The main objectives of the scheme at educational level are as under:-

- (a) Activate School Management Committees (SMCs) to ensure universal enrolment, retention and completion of programmes of girls.
- (b) Create forums to encourage participation of girls through **Balika Manch**.
- (c) Construction and ensuring of functional toilet for girls.
- (d) Campaign to re-enroll drop-out girls.
- (e) Construction of girl’s hostel.
- (f) Sensitization of teachers on Child Sex Ratio through Samagra Shiksha.
- (g) Institutionalize standard guidelines/ protocols for friendly environment for girls in the University and ensure its effective implementation.
- (h) Institute district level awards for felicitating girl-achievers and special award for meritorious girls.

3. The University emphasises on quality education for all the students with special emphases for girl students. University ensures quality of education, security, morale, inculcation of traditional and cultural values amongst the students. University implements/executes the mission of the Prime Minister **“Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao”** with full enthusiasm.


- (a) Registration Fee - Rs. 7,500/-.
